Arrival Systems Launches "A-Safe"

Mobile, AL — Arrival Systems, Inc is proud to announce the launch of A-Safe, a new line of hosted solutions designed to help businesses keep their critical information protected and secure. Beginning with the A-Safe Online Backup Service, the company plans to roll out an entire suite of hosted security solutions by Q4 2006.

"Data security and disaster recovery are of great concern with business leader's everywhere." said C.J. Ezell, President of Arrival Systems. "Given the recent string of natural disasters along the Gulf Coast and elsewhere, we feel it is crucial that businesses have solid data backup and recovery options available to them. This is why we have chosen online backup as the first service to be offered under the new A-Safe product line"

Featuring a 256-bit AES encryption algorithm, A-Safe Online Backup will allow users to secure their data with the same security technology currently utilized by the U.S. Government for documents it classifies as "Top Secret". Advanced Encryption Standard, or AES, was adopted by the U.S. Government in 2001 after a three year competition and is more secure than the 128 bit security measures used by most online banking applications. To date, there has never been a successful attack against AES encryption.

A-Safe also utilizes the internet security protocol known as Secure Sockets Layer, or SSL, to transmit the compressed data to one of two geographically separate backup servers located in state of the art data centers. These data centers restrict physical access to the servers by utilizing security technologies such as biometrics and card key access. Customers can easily recover data at any time with a few simple mouse clicks.

The high level of security in the software will also allow healthcare providers to take advantage of online backup while still staying in compliance with HIPAA regulations. the Health Insurance Portability and Accountability Act (HIPAA) of 1996 was intended to reduce the costs and administrative burdens of health care by making possible the standardized, electronic transmission of many administrative and financial transactions that are currently carried out manually on paper.

"We truly feel that online backup is far superior to every other backup method currently in use in the market." said Ezell "Backups are automated; data is secure and protected from both the human element and Mother Nature."
